Guidelines for granting exemption (Professional Certificate in Teaching and Learning in Higher Education)

New staff may apply to the Programme Leader of the Professional Certificate for Teaching and Learning in Higher Education for exemption. After an application is reviewed, successful cases will be passed to the Director of TALIC for consideration. An exemption will be granted only in exceptional circumstances. For an exemption to be awarded, the staff member must have a teaching certificate certifying completion of a course of equivalent standard and duration or have teaching experience that satisfy the following criteria:

- (a) at least 2 years of teaching,
- (b) in an English-speaking teaching and learning environment,
- (c) full-time (conducted while serving in a full-time capacity, carrying out at least 8 hours of teaching per week),
- (d) taught for at least one semester at HKU, or another institution implementing Outcomes-Based Approach to Student Learning (OBASL)
- (e) successful (demonstrated by student evaluation results and / or reference), and
- (f) recent (within two years of the date of application for exemption).

Applicants may be required to attend an interview in order for his/her eligibility for exemption to be assessed.
